Snap Tape is secure – injection molded snaps consistently placed on polyester woven tape – no attaching machines or dies required. The tape is custom color matched to the bodysuits, elevating the garments appearance. The improved snap and unsnap action allow you to close the garment with one hand.

The infant bodysuit, style 4400, was introduced in 1999 and became a staple item in children's wear. Along with the change on the closure, the design team reshaped the leg opening to align to changes in diaper technology. The Rabbit Skins 4400 bodysuit accommodates the child and diaper without leg opening gaps or sagging. Plus, the expandable shoulders allow easy on and off changing without taking the garment over the child's head. Perfect fit, style and safety - that's what Rabbit Skins delivers.
