Responsibilities

Product Development | Design

- Support the Design|Product Development team throughout the product development process, from conceptualization to production handoff. (Development at LAT Apparel is annual, with one new product launch a year).
- Collaborate with DesignIPD on market and trend research, and sales analysis as we ramp up new development.
- Build and edit sketches in Adobe Illustrator for special projects.
- Assist with photographing samples; at times managing this process independently.
- Track sample shipments and organize in-house samples.
- Measure sample submits, reviewing each against the tech pack construction details.
- Assist with the sample fitting process.
- Support the development and maintenance of tech packs within our PLM system.
- Carry out PLM tech pack projects as needed.
- Auditing the PLM system routinely to clean up, correct, and edit errors.
- Responsible for handing off approved style development tech packs to the QC Team, ensuring that the team is clear on all details; and communicating issues with PD Manager as they arise.

Fabric & Color Management | Quality Control

- Responsible for testing fabric for hand feel, defects, weight, shrinkage, torque, and color reading, and documenting results.
- Supporting the QC Manager with the new fabric decoration testing process and communicating results to the DesignlMerchandising team.
- Communicating fabric and color testing results to our Vendors.
- Creating fabric run swatch cards.
- Responsible for opening all fabric package deliveries, tracking, and logging in details.
- Deliver packages to appropriate team members.
- Read all production garments against approved color standards.

- Train on the DataColor system to utilize and maintain the system.
- Support the lab dip development process by working with the QC Manager and VP of Apparel on color approvals.
- Train in our PLM system processes to become a super user for our QC Team.
- Serve as the primary QC auditor of new styles!
- Flexing as auditor and fabric specialist as needed.
